## **GRANTS TO PROVIDE COMPUTERS**

MONTGOMERY -- A private foundation, funded by a lawsuit settlement with Toshiba Corp., has announced plans to award computers to schools, community groups and individuals in Alabama.

The Beaumont Foundation of America, from Beaumont, Texas, will award \$1.8 million in grants in the state this year, Lt. Gov.-elect Lucy Baxley announced Tuesday.

The grants will go to schools and community groups serving low-income families. Individuals who are poor or disabled also can apply for grants.

W. Frank Newton, president of the foundation, said grant applications would be accepted from now through March.
